1.	<p>Important Lindenwood baroque tall-case Sacristy Clock, heavily carved throughout. Face has a 5" round painting of a Saint - possibly "John of Nepomuk" with outstretched arms. Below this reserve is a painted circle of the moon & stars in color. Twelve Roman numerals w/minute marks of "five" surrounding the border.</p> <p>The 10" narrow case is deeply carved leaves and scrolls - one section has a Crowing Cock, 4½" wide in excellent detail. At pendulum's end is a "window" with a circle of thorns through which can be seen the swinging pendulum. Lower section of the case has a deeply carved basket weave design. Movement of clock has hand-wrought steel plates, long slender brass weights, lead filled. The above clock is of Museum quality and appears to be mid 18th Century.</p> <p>PROVENANCE: Austrian.</p> <p>Note: Clock was repaired approx. 30 years ago and is in excellent condition and repair.</p>	\$ 6,000.00
